Christmas Paintings by Illustrator Michael Dudash

The joy of the Christmas season comes alive in a new exhibit of paintings by famed artist and illustrator Michael Dudash. With a varied career in illustration that began in 1977, the artist has completed over 1,800 original paintings. Famous for Clint Eastwood movie posters, Dudash has created movie illustrations for film studios such as Warner Brothers, 20th Century Fox, and Universal Studios. He has illustrated for magazine publishers like Time/Life, McCalls, and Reader's Digest; but he has also created book covers and illustrations for publishers like Bantam Books, Penguin Books, Random House, and Simon & Schuster.

"The Story of the Nativity: Christmas Paintings by Illustrator Michael Dudash" is an exhibit celebrating the birth of Jesus. Each of these original oil paintings will take you along every chapter of the story of the nativity. You will journey on the flight to Egypt with Mary and Joseph, then to Bethlehem where there is 'no room at the inn', and finally witness for yourself the blessed event of Saviour's birth.

Museum Curator Scott Peck: "Dudash seems to have an uncanny ability to capture the romance of Christmas that we all share in our memories. The tenderness of emotion in his painting is sweetly sacred and holy." Authentic faith is at the core of Dudash's identity. The artist proclaims: "I labor to be an empty vessel for Jesus Christ, and hope that in the end He will say, 'Well done thou good and faithful servant.'
